All deadlines are strict and cannot be extended. Candidates are strongly urged to lodge their forms well before deadline. All forms must be electronically submitted to the Returning Officer via latrobereturningofficer@gmail.com

POLLING

Polling will occur from 10am Monday 7 September to 2pm Thursday 10 September 2026. All students are eligible to vote in the elections, regardless of whether they are members of LTSU. Notwithstanding this, Postgraduate student positions are to be elected by only Postgraduate students respectively. Polling will be held using a secure online voting platform.

Voting and campaigning on campus will be facilitated during the election period with a polling clerk located in the Agora between 10:00am-4:00pm between the Monday and Wednesday of polling as well at 10:00am-2:00pm on the final day of polling. The polling clerk will monitor campaign behaviour and provide support for voters accessing their voting links, as needed. In-person campaigning on campus is only allowed for the periods that the polling clerk is present.

POLICY STATEMENTS

All candidates may submit at the time of their nomination a policy statement not exceeding 300 words for office bearer candidates and 100 words for all other candidates and a photo for publication on the LTSU website and on the ballot. Please provide these at the time of nomination lodgement by emailing the Returning Officer. Any statements or photos submitted after the close of nominations will not be accepted.

Policy statements should be in plain text and photos should be less than 500MB file size and in a standard format such as .jpeg, .gif or .png.

TICKETS

Applications to re-register a ticket name from 2025 or transfer the registration of an existing ticket name must be received by 5pm on Friday 14 August 2026.

A group of candidates, consisting of the following may apply to have their name or names set out on the ballot paper under the name of a ticket, to appear throughout the ballot;

- At least 3 Executive Positions
- At least 1 candidate for 4 Office Bearer Positions
- At least 4 General Member Positions
- Have at least 12 unique Candidates.

The name of the ticket must not exceed 4 words.

Any student member may register a ticket name by emailing the relevant form to the Returning Officer by 5pm on Monday 17 August 2026.

When a ticket name is registered, the candidates wishing to run under that name in multi-member ballots must all sign an application to be set out as a ticket in the candidate order to appear on the ballot. This form is available online.

***ELIGIBILITY QUALIFICATIONS**

Any student member may nominate for the La Trobe University Student Union Inc. Student Council and Office bearing positions, and all students can vote in the elections.

Two student members who are each eligible may together stand for and hold any officer-bearer position, except President, Education Vice-President, General Secretary, Welfare Vice-President and Postgraduate Officer. This includes Editor of Rabelais. Each candidate must complete a nomination form, indicating that they intend to share the position with the other student member.

For the 7 general members of the Student Council, at least 3 of the members must be women, provided sufficient numbers of women nominate. One of the general members must identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student (if nominated). There is no such requirement for NUS delegate positions.

The Disabilities Officer must identify as having a disability or being a carer.

The People of Colour Officer must identify as being a person of colour.

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Officer must identify as being Aboriginal or a Torres Strait Islander.

The Queer Officer must identify as queer.

The Women's Officer and Committee members must identify as women.

The Postgraduate Officer and Committee must be postgraduate students.

The Residential Officer must be a resident on campus accommodation at the time of close of nominations.

Candidates may stand for but not hold more than one office-bearer position, more than one position on the same Student Union body or any position on the Student Council and any other directly elected position.

INFORMATION SESSIONS

I will be running election information sessions which will cover information about the elections, its rules and expectations. This is crucially important as it will cover election participant behaviour, university and student protocols, campaign restrictions as well as answer questions. This will run for an hour and election participants should attend this session. Further information will be made available on the LTSU Election Webpage.
